



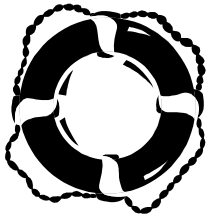

An adult will be supervising the sleepover.

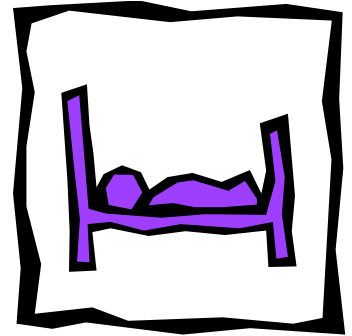
The supervisors will be members of the club that the children are familiar with. The leaders for the night will be:

### **T-Shirts**

As you may be aware, we have had some delays, but I think they are well worth the wait.

The shirt must be worn to each Junior Lifeguard session, so that we can identify the children and so that they are all part of a team.

As this shirt is now your child's, please wash the shirt ready for the following week.

If the shirts are lost, a replacement shirt will be provided, at a cost of \$10- (this is heavily subsidised by the club).
