## Lifesavers kept busy

LIFESAVERS were kept busy yesterday with 15 rescues performed at Alexandra Headlands Beach alone.

Two Brisbane families had to be pulled in after they got out of their depth at the popular tourist stretch.

Another family had to be rescued at Caloundra, after they tried to swim across the passage from Bulcock Beach to Bribie Island.

A lifesaving spokesperson said it was a timely reminder to take care in the ocean.

Only swim between the flags and dont swim out of your depth, he said.

People need to remember the ocean can be unpredictable and while everyone today was safe, it could have ended in tragedy.

Lifesavers were also kept busy patrolling the sand, after a couple were found at Alex committing an indecent act in public.

Police attended, but were unable to locate the couple.

A man was also seen exposing himself at a Marcoola Beach.

The spokesperson said he was removed from the beach.
