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The Marcoola Surf Carnival was called off yesterday and six Sunshine Coast beaches had to be closed due to dangerous conditions.

The rough conditions also resulted in lifesavers rescuing nine swimmers across the Coast.

Two people were rescued in Noosa after being swept out from the bar on a surf ski, and another person was picked up from a capsized kayak at Bulcock beach.

Three boardriders were assisted after attempting to cross the Pumicestone Passage in the early afternoon.

Lifesavers also had to help a kite-surfer who was stuck at Maroochydore Beach, and another person was rescued when their wave runner experienced engine trouble.

One person at Bribie Island was treated for a head cut, and four children were given oxygen after feeling faint at Caloundra.
